

Far West Mining & Civil is a company that was established by the Far West Coast Native Title Holders to create wealth for the development of education, employment and economic participation for Aboriginal peoples of the Far West Coast.

The business's core activity is the leasing of machinery and equipment to the mining industry but is at a stage where the company is looking to diversify so as to be sustainable past the life of mining.



The company was started by Pidinga Munda Investments with a commercial loan from Indigenous Business Australia that was used to purchase a D10 Bull Dozer that has been hired to Exact Mining at the Jacinth-Ambrosia Mineral Sands Project (operated by Iluka Resources).

The company exists for the sole purpose of generating an income that is distributed to the Far West Coast Aboriginal Community Charitable Trust.

Far West Mining & Civil is a work in progress. The company directors are confident that this business will become a strong source of funding for the Far West Coast Aboriginal Community Charitable Trust with a view to delivering economic independence for Aboriginal people.
